



Student Placement Policy

We recognise that the quality and variety of work which goes on in a preschool makes it an ideal place for students. Students taking courses in childcare are suitable.

Students are welcome into preschool under the following conditions:

- The needs of the children are paramount. Students will not be admitted in numbers that hinder the essential work of the preschool.
- Students must be confirmed by their tutor as being linked to a bona fide childcare course that provides necessary background understanding of children's development and activities.
- All students will go through an induction process regarding the relevant policies of the preschool. This will include signing the confidentiality agreement. All students will hold a current DBS check through their college/university (except if they are still at school).
- Students required to conduct child studies will obtain written permission from the parents of the children to be studied. Agreement by the Leader in the first instance.
- Confidentiality must be adhered to at all times, with regard to information gathered by the student. This includes information about the child, their families or other adults in the preschool.
- Parents will be informed via the daily notice board when there is a student working within the preschool.
- Every student must agree to these conditions.
